

# Welcome

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Thank you for your interest in Grace Christian School.

It is the purpose of Grace Christian School to provide a sound academic education integrated with a Christian view of God and His world.

Enclosed are the registration materials and information about our school. Since our openings are limited, I would recommend returning the Admissions Packet and Application Fee as soon as possible. In filling our classes for next year, a high priority will be given to those families who share the school's mission in its entirety, are closely connected with a local evangelical church body, and who believe in the spiritual foundations of the school. In view of this we ask you to carefully review the Mission Statement, Parent-School Agreement, and Statement of Faith found in your application packet. Also, be sure to examine the current Fee Schedule found in your packet or online.

Our application procedure is as follows:

1. Obtain an Admissions Packet either from our office or online at [www.gracechristian.org](http://www.gracechristian.org).
2. Return the completed Application Form, a copy of your student's most recent report card, and the \$60.00 non-refundable Application Fee. If your student has an Individual Education Plan, please submit a copy, along with the most recent IEP evaluation. Middle School students must also complete the Middle School Survey.
3. Distribute the Pastoral Reference, Personal Reference, and the Student Academic Report to appropriate individuals. (*Academic Report does not apply to 3 and 4 year old Pre-School/Pre-K*). It is your responsibility to ensure that these are mailed or faxed to the school in a timely fashion.
4. When all of the above listed materials have been received, an interview with the Administration will be scheduled. (A second interview is not uncommon, nor is a request for additional references).
5. If your student meets enrollment qualifications and openings are available at the time of your interview, a space may be offered to you. Your registration payment will secure that space.
6. If openings are not available at the time of your interview, your qualified student will be placed in a Wait Pool. Priority may be assigned based on the above mentioned criteria. You will be notified if space opens up for your student.
7. Students entering during the school year may be enrolled on a probationary status.
